

## ***Coach Job Description***

**Purpose** – To be a living representative of the “life of Christ” to your players and their families by building relationships with the players and families and guiding them toward taking a step in the process of beginning their relationship with Christ

**Theme verse** – “Be wise in the way you act toward outsiders; make the most of every opportunity. Let your conversation be always full of grace, seasoned with salt, so that you may know how to answer everyone.” Colossians 4:5,6

### **Duties**

- 1) To build relationships with your players and their families in order to prepare their hearts for the “seed” of truth
- 2) To look for opportunities to share the “seed” of the word with your players and their families
- 3) To graciously speak the “seed” of truth – beginning with the impact it is having on you – to your players and their families when the opportunity arises
- 4) To teach your players how sports can be used to build character – utilizing the materials provided to you
- 5) To develop each player in his or her sports ability
- 6) To develop each player in his or her approach to sports and then life
- 7) To abide by the guidelines and rules of the league
- 8) To utilize sports to teach life lessons to your players
- 9) To appoint a team parent
- 10) To attend all practices and games
- 11) To attend appropriate league and coaches’ meetings
- 12) To hold a parents’ meeting before the first game to go over league philosophy
